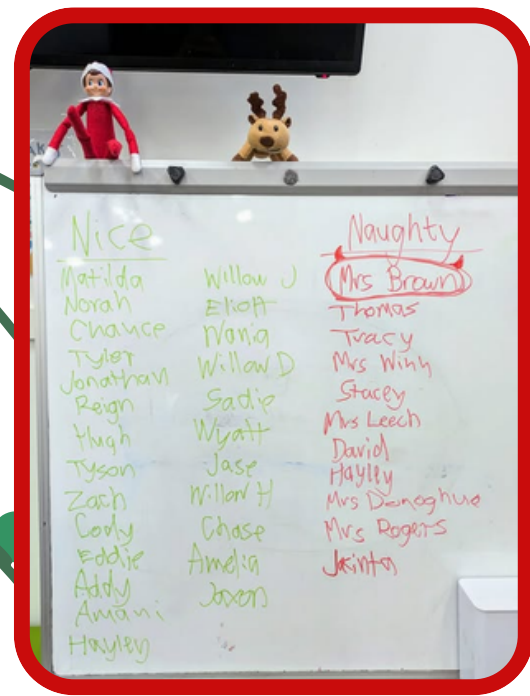
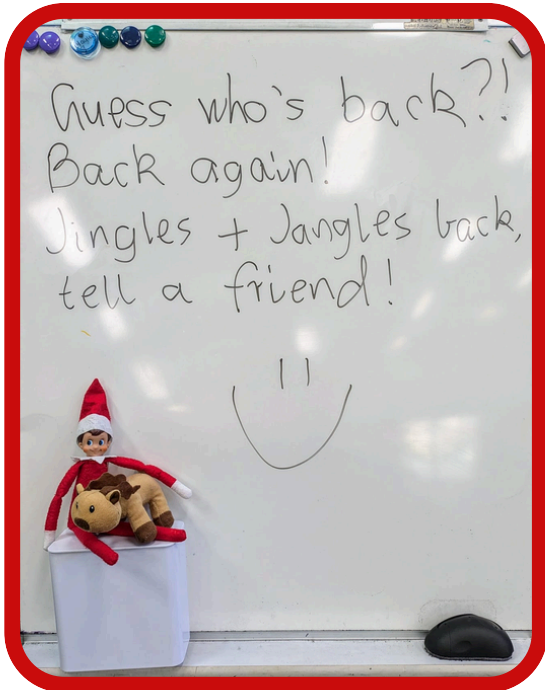

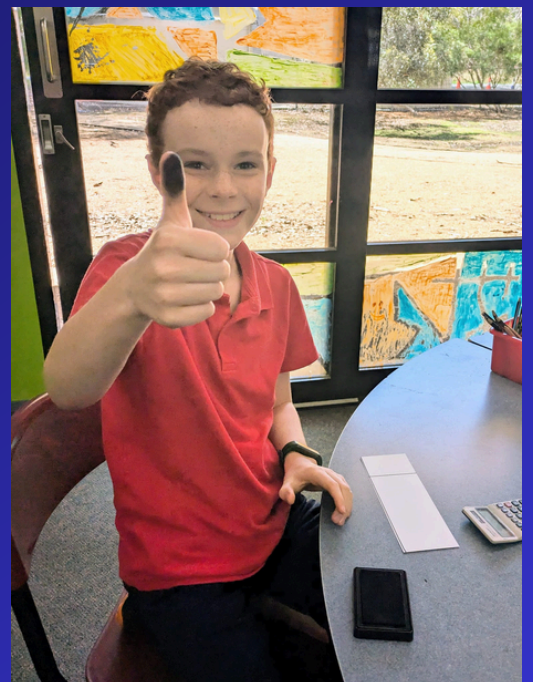

## Child Safe Standard 8 – Child safety knowledge, skills and awareness

At Mooroopna North PS our work within this standard includes;

- Our Child Safety and Wellbeing Policy outlines the controls in place to ensure school council and school staff receive appropriate annual guidance and training on child safety and is implemented
- Our Volunteers policy provides information on training for volunteers.
- Volunteers are provided with child safety training that is appropriate to the activity and the volunteer’s role.

The Child Safe Standards are compulsory minimum standards for all Victorian schools to ensure they are well prepared to keep children and young people safe and protect them from abuse. The Child Safe Standards include requirements to keep children, young people and students safe. There are eleven Child Safe Standards. Each newsletter we will introduce a one standard keeping you informed of our work supporting and implementing the standards.

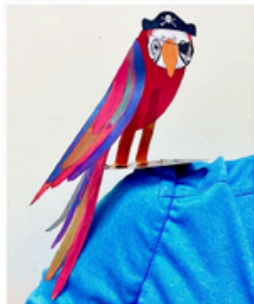

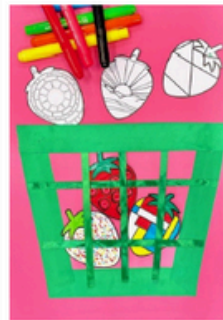

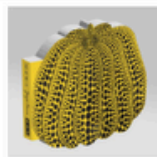
