We are enjoying having out friends from Ardmona PS visiting our school.

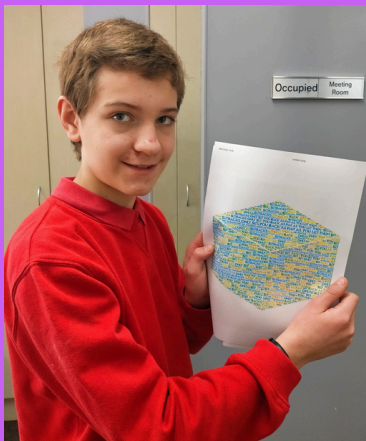


Occupational Therapy at MNPS

PROTECT

Protecting children & young people from abuse is our responsibility



The Child Safe Standards are compulsory minimum standards for all Victorian schools to ensure they are well prepared to keep children and young people safe and protect them from abuse. The Child Safe Standards include requirements to keep children, young people and students safe. There are eleven Child Safe Standards. Each newsletter we will introduce a one standard keeping you informed of our work supporting and implementing the standards.

Child Safe Standard 11 – Implementation of child safety practices

At Mooroopna North PS our work within this standard includes;

- Our suite of child safety and wellbeing policies and procedures address all aspects of the Child Safe Standards
- Our staff and relevant volunteers are inducted and trained on our child safety and wellbeing policies, procedures and practices and are supported to implement them
- Our school leaders champion and model our child safety policies, procedures and practices and address any performance concerns relating to staff conduct or implementation
- Our Child Safety Champion regularly reviews [PROTECT guidance](#) and other relevant policies to ensure our own local child safety policies, procedures and practices are informed by best practice and updated where required.

The Victorian Government has announced new [Child Safe Standards](#) to further strengthen child safety across organisations, including schools. The new standards recognise the critical importance of families and the broader school community in maintaining and promoting child safety and wellbeing.
